In accordance with our Archbishop's Decree, public Masses will resume at Holy Trinity beginning May 9th and 10th with our regular weekend and daily Mass schedule.

Please remember that the number of people that can be in attendance is very much limited, due to the current restrictions to mitigate the spread of the coronavirus.

If chosen, you will be asked to arrive no later than 10 minutes before the Holy Mass, as the church will be locked once the number of people allowed is reached. We kindly ask you to respect the social distance of at least 6' for your own protection; it is advised that you wear a mask.

As per the Decree, *“Holy Communion is to be distributed only on the hand during this period of time, because of the danger of transmitting the coronavirus through reception on the tongue.”*

For those unable to attend the Holy Mass, we will start live-streaming our 11 am & 1 pm Masses. Be aware that if you are not able to attend the Holy Mass due to the restrictions and risks, our Archbishop has granted dispensation from the obligation to participate in the Sunday celebration of the Holy Eucharist.
